



Consent to personal data processing

given pursuant to the provision of Article 7 of Regulation (EU) no. 2016/679 of the European Parliament and of the Council on the protection of natural persons with regard to the processing of personal data and on the free movement of such data and in compliance with Article 14 of the Act No. 18/2018 Coll. on Personal Data Protection and on the amendment of certain other Acts.

The Legal Representative of the Data Subject **by his/her signature freely and voluntarily gives a consent** for processing of personal data for a controller which is **QSI International School of Bratislava**, Záhradnícka 1006/2, 93101, Šamorín (hereinafter as „the **Controller**“).

The Consent is given for the purpose of processing of effigy (photography) of the Data Subject. After the Consent had been given the Controller shall be entitled to collect the photographs of the Data Subjects, to store them in separate file of a student/child, to use them in school publications, or to use them for a promotion of school and school activities by means of publishing them on social networks.

Processing of acquired effigy shall be in progress until the Legal Representative withdraws his/her Consent to personal data processing, however not longer than for a period of five years.

Giving of the Consent is voluntary. Without a given consent, the Controller shall not be entitled to collect photographs of children or students and to use them for the above-mentioned purpose.

You have a **right to withdraw** the given Consent **at any time** and this by contacting the Controller by means of the contact details specified in letterhead of this Consent.

Should we treat your personal data, you have a right to an access to the personal data, right to a rectification and erasure of the personal data, right to restriction of processing of the personal data or a right to portability of given personal data to another Controller.

The abovementioned requirements might be claimed before the Controller on the above-mentioned contact details.

Should you assume that a breach of a law might have occurred, you have a right to file a complaint with the Office for Personal Data Protection of the Slovak Republic.
